- **Does your question make sense?**
- **Is it obvious what is expected from an answer to your question?**
- **Which topics are relevant to your question**
- **Are the too few or too many elements to cover within a comprehensive answer to your question?**
- **Does your question only require knowledge which is in the specification?**
- **Does your mark scheme cover all elements of the question?**
- **If applicable, does your mark scheme contain some sporting examples?**
