



# Six Nations - Scotland v Wales

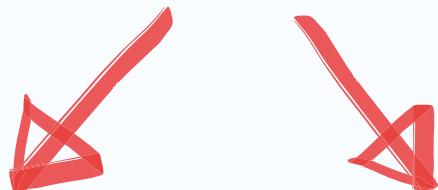
