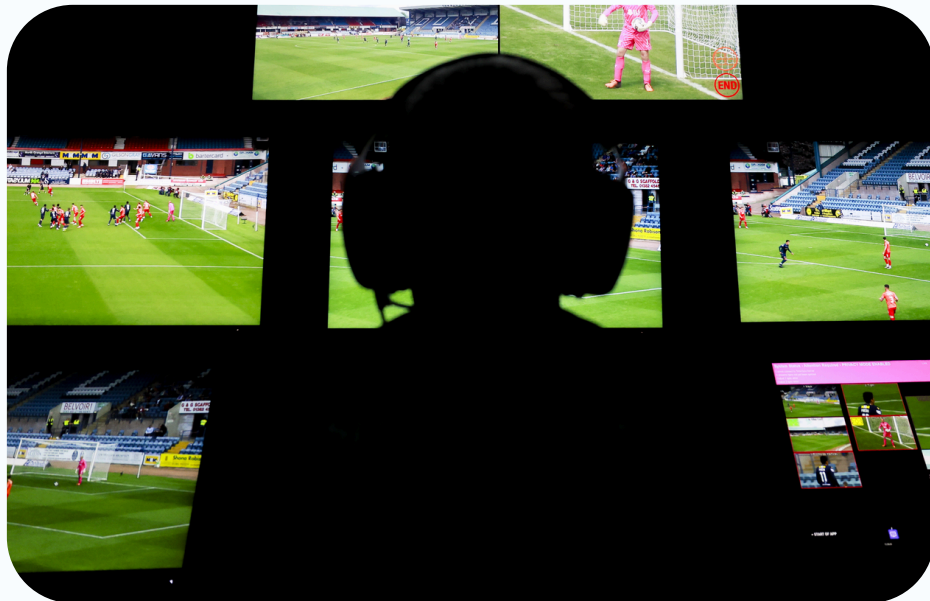


# SPORT IN THE NEWS
